***FIRST ARTICLE INSPECTION**

Seller shall perform a First Article Inspection in conjunction with Boeing Source Inspection at initial buy, and shall perform a comparable inspection at production change points or for specified articles following inspection tooling changes, design changes, or evident Quality degradation, and shall present documentation to Buyer, as a minimum:

- (a) Drawings, specifications, and other documentation used for manufacture processing, inspection and test of the "first article;"
- (b) Objective evidence of inspection acceptance of tooling and test equipment used to produce the "first article;"
- (c) Objective evidence of Seller's inspection, including recording of actual values, and acceptance of the "first article."

* First Article Inspection consists of a verification of all drawing characteristics at the detail, subassembly and assembly level. All drawing notes which are inspection characteristics are to be included.
