

# RC-31A

## \*FIRST ARTICLE INSPECTION

Seller shall perform a First Article Inspection at initial buy, and shall perform a comparable inspection at production change points or for specified articles following inspection tooling changes, design changes, or evident Quality degradation, and shall present documentation to Buyer, as a minimum:

- (a) Drawings, specifications, and other documentation used for manufacture processing, inspection and test of the "First Article;"
- (b) Objective evidence of inspection acceptance of tooling and test equipment used to produce the "First Article;"
- (c) Objective evidence of Seller's inspection, including recording of actual values, and acceptance of the "First Article."

Seller may use their own First Article Report format providing the following information is included:

- (a) Part Number
- (b) Part Name
- (c) Drawing Revision
- (d) Attached Engineering Orders
- (e) Supplier Name
- (f) Serial or Lot Number
- (g) Each Engineering/Drawing characteristics with the drawing location as well as drawing notes, shall be listed with the actual values recorded, as applicable.
- (h) Seller's Acceptance Stamp.

\* First Article Inspection consists of a verification of all drawing characteristics at the detail, subassembly and assembly level. All drawing notes which are inspection characteristics are to be included.
