

## **RC-63 INSPECTION RECORD RETENTION**

Paragraphs 3.5 and 3.4 "Records" - Imposed by Specification STO802GT0001/STO802GT0002 and STO802GT0008/STO802GT0003 respectively under Code 20 of Buyer's Purchase Contract are supplemented and the following provisions apply:

Seller and Seller's Subcontractors shall maintain verifiable objective evidence of all inspections and tests performed, results obtained and dispositions of non-conforming articles. These records shall be identified to associated articles, including heat and lot numbers of materials, unit or lot serialization when applicable. These records shall be made available to Buyer and/or Government Representatives upon request, and shall be retained in a safe, accessible location for a period of thirty (30) years.

Records held for the required retention period (thirty years) shall not be destroyed without Buyer's written concurrence. Contact Buyer for concurrence.

Except for Distributors and Warehouses where records retention is imposed by specification STO802GT0003 under Code 20 of Buyer's Purchase Contract, seller's records associated with the manufacture or serialized or lot controlled articles will provide for continued traceability of serial numbers or lot number identification through all phases of manufacture, commencing with the raw material and continuing through final acceptance of the end item.

The Government has the right to inspect any or all of the work included in this order at the supplier's plant.
