

APPENDIX I

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMMERCIAL ITEMS UNDER U.S. GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS & SUBCONTRACTS

The terms in this Appendix supplement Buyer's Standard Term and Conditions of Purchase for Commercial Purchases of Goods and Services. In interpreting and applying the following clauses, and as the context requires, the term "Contractor" shall mean Supplier, the term "Contract" shall mean this order, and the term "Government", "Contracting Officer" and equivalent phrases shall mean Buyer and/or Buyer's purchasing representative.

Notwithstanding the prior paragraph, the terms "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change:

- ⑩ When a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the U.S. Government or a U.S. Government designated Contracting Officer or his/her duly-authorized representative; or
- ⑩ When title to property is to be transferred directly to the U.S. Government; or
- ⑩ Where reference is specifically made to the "U.S. Government" or to a "U.S. Government Contracting Officer".

FAR and DFARS Clauses Incorporated in Agreements for the Purchase of Commercial Items:

The following FAR and DOD FAR Supplement clauses (including alternates), as modified by Federal Acquisition Circulars and other agency Acquisition Circulars respectively, on the date of and required by the prime contract identified on the face of this order, are hereby incorporated by reference and made a material part hereof. If there is a conflict between or among one or more clauses herein, or an addition to a clause after the effective date of this order, the version of the clause applicable to this order shall be the version of the clause in the prime contract.
