Subject: Pratt and Whitney Rocketdyne (PWR) Supplier Quality Initiative, Canoga Park

Dear Supplier:

As a result of nonconformance escape focus group, PWR is changing our Source Inspection process for production programs for selected PWR designed components. All purchase contract line items designated with the new quality clause Q203C will require source inspection releases and the use of the AS9102 forms for all shipments.

Details of the changes are as follows:

- Existing Purchase Contracts in work for Production program deliverable product delivering after July 1st are subject to this new process based on program and supplier mutually agreeable terms negotiated by the Buyer.
- New orders or new line items to existing purchase contracts will contain, a new Quality Clause entitled "Q203C" in lieu of using the Supplier Portal Electronic Certificate of Conformance referred to in the purchase contract as Q078.
- Please take this opportunity to become familiarized with the updated quality clauses; Reference web link: http://www.rocketdynetech.com/supplierinfo/common_tc/common-q/pwr_clauses.htm.
- If the product/material being ordered requires Specification RC5166 Metallic Material Testing, then access to the Nexprise system is required prior to Source Inspection taking place. Refer to the new Quality Clause Q218C.
- The PWR Supplier Portal call system referred to "Automated Source Inspection Request System" ASIRS will continue to be used to request PWR Source Inspection and requires 7 day advance notice to the extent practical.
