Subject: Use of Alternate Revisions to Specifications

Dear Sir:

In an effort to improve our procurement and quality processes at Pratt & Whitney Rocketdyne we will be incorporating the following statement in our Procured Product Acceptance Requirements (PPAR's) issued on or after October 1, 2009.

***Use of Alternate Revisions to CSP/SMPP Specifications: The Seller may work to either the stated specification revision, to "one" revision earlier or to "any later version" of that which is stated herein. In doing so the Seller will ensure that all alternate revisions are reviewed, and Seller or sub-tier is approved and compliant to that specific revision.***

“CSP” refers to a Certified Special Process and “SMPP” refers to a Supplier Manufacturing Process Plan.

Change notices, incorporating this provision into existing Purchase Orders **will not be issued, unless specifically requested by the Supplier.** If you wish to invoke this process on an existing order with PWR, please contact your Buyer and request that a revised PPAR be incorporated in the Purchase Order.
